NO VETERAN LEFT BEHIND PROGRAM

CHEROKEE COUNTY VETERANS APPRECIATION PARK



Brick Program - The park is paved with bricks in honor and/or memory of our Cherokee County Veterans. Bricks can be purchased at the VA Office for \$100. New bricks are placed in the park once a year.

T-Shirt Program – Each year, T-shirts are made and sold around Veterans Day. Veteran's names are placed on the back of the shirts in honor or memory of the veteran. The cost is \$10 per name added. To add a veteran's name, come by the office and complete a T-shirt form.

Veterans Book - A Veterans' Day Book is published each year. We encourage all veterans or veterans' families to bring a picture of the veteran by our office to have it added to the book. Books are published and sold for \$5 each around Veterans Day.

All proceeds from these programs are used to maintain the Veterans Park.
