

NOTICE OF ELECTION

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

COUNTY OF CHEROKEE

The City of Chesnee will hold an election on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, to elect a Mayor and two (2) council seats. To be eligible to vote you must be a registered voter in Cherokee County AND reside within the City of Chesnee at least 30 days prior to the election.

Any person wishing to vote in this election, who is not already a registered voter in Cherokee County, must register no later than Friday, October 2, 2021. You may check your voter registration status at www.scvotes.gov.

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo IDs when voting in person:

- S.C Driver’s License
- ID card issued by the DMV
- S.C. Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
- Concealed Weapons Permit

At 9:00 A.M. on November 2, 2021, the Cherokee County Election Commission will begin examining the absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held at the Cherokee County Election Commission office located at 110 Railroad Avenue in Gaffney, SC 29340, 864-902-2330.

On Thursday, November 4, 2021 at 9 a.m., the County Board of Canvassers will conduct a hearing to determine the validity of all provisional ballots cast in these elections. This hearing will be held at the Cherokee County Election Commission office.

The following precincts and polling locations will be open on ELECTION DAY from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.
