Exhibit A

The following is open for bid at Cherokee County Administration Building, 110 Railroad Av., Gaffney, SC 29340.

1. Bidder must be a dealer or individual who deals in the recycle metal.
2. Dealer must be able to transport metal to their location for processing.
3. Dealer or individual must remove all scrap metal, including propane tanks, etc.
4. Dealer or individual must be in good financial stability.
5. Dealer or individual must show proof of all insurance this includes worker's comp and must be included with bid.
6. Dealer must be able to dispose of the Freon in all equipment and meet all standards set by DHEC.
7. The highest bidder must be able to start and complete the job within 45 days after the bid has been awarded.
8. Bid must be priced on a 2,000-pound tonnage price.
