

# Candidate Filing

Opens: Saturday, March 16, 2024, at Noon

Closes: Monday, April 1, 2024, at Noon

- Time of filing is declared when the candidate enters the Voter Registration main door of our lobby.
  - Not front door of county building
  - Our office will use the county cell phone to declare the time.
  - If you must leave our office to retrieve an item that is needed for filing, time begins when you re-enter Voter Registration main door lobby.
- Complete the Statement of Intention of Candidacy form.
  - **DO NOT** sign until you are filing with an election staff person.
  - If you do not have a form, please ask and one will be provided.
- Must have check, cashier's check or money order in hand. NO CASH.
  - Make payable to State Political Party.
