

SC Statewide Primary will be held on June 11, 2024 (7am-7pm). Early voting will open Tuesday, May 28, 2024 – Friday, June 7, 2024 (Monday, May 27 closed for holiday). Hours will be 8:30am – 5:00pm; No Saturdays. Deadline to register to vote was in person was Friday, May 10; online was Sunday, May 12; and by mail was postmarked by Monday, May 13. Deadline to request and return an absentee by mail application is Friday, May 31.

For more information, anyone may visit www.scvotes.gov or www.cherokeecountysc.gov -click on the Voter Registration tab. We encourage voters to update their address if they have moved since the last election cycle.

This primary consists of only 4 county council seats. County Council District 1, County Council District 3, County Council District 4, and County Council District 6. A voter must be registered before the deadline and live inside one of those 4 districts to be eligible to vote in this election. Only 21 out of 29 precincts will be open on Election Day due to 8 of our precincts not having their county council district seat up for re-election this year. Also, this is not a county-wide ballot because our Senator, US House Representative, State House Representatives, and Solicitor all were without “same-party” opposition which sent them straight to the November General Election.
