The Contractor is to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and permits (if any are required) to complete the below referenced project based on the following scope of work:

Existing RTUs to be removed:

- 1. A steam boiler supplies heat for the courthouse, front offices, and the judges chambers
- 2. One RTU supplies AC to the courtroom
- 3. One RTU supplies AC to the front offices
- 4. One split system supplies AC to the judges chambers
- 5. The county proposes to have the steam boiler turned off and the hot water coils, two RTU's, and one split system removed

The county is proposing to have installed:

- One Trane/American Standard gas fired-electric RTU for the Courtroom equivalent to the existing equipment
- One Trane/American Standard gas fired-electric RTU for the Solicitors offices equivalent to the existing equipment
- One Trane/American Standard gas fired-electric RTU for the Judges Chambers equivalent to the existing equipment

Proposed Scope of Work

- Remove the HVAC equipment from the roof and the attic space
- Demo the remaining hot water coils by leaving the frames and cutting out the coils
- Install two new Trane/American Standard RTU's for the courtroom and front office areas
- Install a Trane/American Standard RTU for the judge's chambers
 - This installation will require a roof penetration for the ductwork
 - o This proposal includes the roofing work
- Reconnect the new HVAC equipment to the existing ductwork and repair any ductwork if needed
- Verify the existing electrical circuit and include upgrades if necessary
- Install new thermostats for each unit

- Install a new gas line from the meter to the equipment on the roof
- The contractor will be responsible for any equipment needed for this bid (including cranes)
- All equipment and debris relating to this project will be removed from the site
- All work will need to be scheduled in advance with the Clerk Of Court, Brandy
 McBee and the Director Of Maintenance, James Pruitt
- In this proposal, the contractor will also include a two-year, semi-annual PM service agreement.
