All questions and answers for RFP 2025-18 Roof Replacement at the LEC

- 1.) Most manufacturers and consultants want a max insulation thickness of 2.6" or less. The specs are unclear on whether you want 1 layer of 3.5" ISO or multiple layers (2) with staggered joints between the first and second layer. Could you clarify?- It is our understanding that SC Code states 3.5 with an R factor of 20. If you do use multiple layers, you will need to stagger the joints.
- 2.) There is no mention of replacing the exterior conductor heads and downspouts. Are they to remain? they are to remain
- 3.) What is the spacing you wish for the new pipe supports for the gas lines? Replace existing blocks with a non wood product for support
- 4.) There is structural slope in the roof deck, and we are only providing crickets between the thruwall scuppers. Is that correct? yes
- 5.) Bids are due by 12:00pm on February 18<sup>th</sup>, but will not be opened until 5:00pm at the County Council meeting? yes
- 6.) We self-perform all our roofing work, will other contractors be allowed to subcontract this work out? We are not sure if the winning bidder will subcontract or not but the winning contractor will be responsible to make sure the job is properly done
- 7.) Will the County require a certified payroll? No

8. Is a Bid Bond Required? Security Amount or Percentage? What documents will be required? AIA or does the County have their own? -no bid bonds are required

9. Will a Payment and Performance Bond going to be required? What documents will be required? AIA or does the County have their own? no bid bonds are required. Please see bid package for required documentation

10. Are there any Liquidated Damages assigned? If so, how much? -No

- 11. Completion Days before Liquidated Damages are assessed? -No
- 12. Will Permit Fees be required or waived? Contractor's responsibility, see scope of work
- 13. Unit costs for deck replacement? -unsure

14. Has an Asbestos Survey been performed? Is it available for review? - No

15. What is the roof decking? Pre-Formed Metal decking, Lightweight concrete? Structural concrete? Tectum? Gypsum? Metal decking is already there. Replace only if damaged

16. Has a core sample been made? Can we core it ourselves if one is not provided? -one was done the day of the pre-bid meeting but if you didn't see it you can contact Tim Hartman to schedule a time to do your own

17. Is the roof structurally sloped? Flat? -sloped

18. Will new wood blocking be necessary and should be included in the bid? Unit cost for deteriorated wood blocking? – See bullet point 5 in scope of work

19. New scuppers? Collection boxes and downspouts need to be included? - No

20. Will the gas lines need to be wire brushed, primed and then painted? -painted

21. Will the PVC need to be 60 mil nominal? Minimum? -see 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet point in scope of work

22. Who will be responsible for the disconnects and reconnects of the mechanical equipment? - If needed, contractor is responsible

23. Will there be an outside third party in charge of inspections and assuring the Contract Documents are being followed and adhered to? - per code, county and city inspectors

24. Can the insulation be mechanically attached? The cover board to? - No, it needs to be glued
