SUMMARY OF WORK

New flooring must be Industrial Kitchen Grade:

Seamless epoxy or equivalent is preferred. Must be highly durable, low maintenance and long lasting. All surfaces to receive resinous flooring are to be mechanically abraded/

grinded. Etching and/or bead-blasting should not be used. Strength and Durability

Abrasion and Chemical Resistant Low Maintenance and Low Odor High Moisture Tolerance

High Traffic and Non-Slip Surface

SUMMARY OF WORK

The current tile flooring may be removed or covered

New flooring should be replaced with seamless resinous flooring.

All Kitchen equipment that is touching the floor will need to be moved and stored until the project is completed. The equipment will need to be placed back in the original positions at the end of the project.

Materials

Materials are to meet all applicable codes, regulations, and

industry standards.

Poly-Crete SLB is a 3/16" seamless, 100% Solids, cement-urethane, self-leveling, concrete resurfacing system with a natural quartz aggregate broadcast providing a slip resistant, gloss finish.

Labor

New resinous epoxy coated flooring systems shall be highly durable, low maintenance and long lasting. Resinous flooring shall be installed in identified kitchen area. All surfaces to receive resinous flooring are to be mechanically abraded/grinded. Etching and/or bead-blasting shall not be used.
