This is a full-time position responsible for assisting the Facilities Maintenance Manager with duties associated with general county facility upkeep. To qualify for this role, you must have a general knowledge of Plumbing, HVAC, Electrical, and Carpentry. This position performs general maintenance and repair work on buildings, equipment, grounds, and related facilities; and performs semi-skilled manual work involving building maintenance, plumbing, electrical, carpentry, painting and drywall, custodial or other maintenance projects. This role will be performed under the guidance and direction of the Facilities Maintenance Manager.

Performs various plumbing tasks: troubleshoots plumbing problems: installs and repairs plumbing fixtures; clears and unblocks water lines and drains; repairs toilets, sinks, faucets, etc. and repairs plumbing leaks. Performs emergency repairs promptly and efficiently.	50%
