Any contract will require an ordinance, including three readings and a public hearing. Donnie Hardin seconded. Voting in favor: Donnie Hardin, Tracy McDaniel, Tim Spencer, David Smith, Teresa Bonner and Elliott Hughes. Opposed: Billy Blanton. Motion carried 6 to 1.

As there was no other business to come before council at this time, Chairman Spencer adjourned the meeting at 1:16 PM.
