

## NOTICE OF ELECTIONS

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

COUNTY OF CHEROKEE

The County Council District 7 Special General Election will be held on Tuesday, April 14, 2026. Any necessary runoffs will be held on Tuesday, April 28, 2026.

Any person wishing to vote in this election and/or runoffs must register no later than Sunday, March 15, 2026 @ 11:59pm. Voter registration by mail forms will be accepted if postmarked by Monday, March 16, 2026.

The early voting period for this election begins on Monday, March 30, 2026, and ends on Friday, April 10, 2026. The following early voting centers will be open during the early voting period from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (closed Weekends & Holidays): Cherokee County Voter Registration & Election Office, 110 Railroad Ave, Gaffney, SC 29340. Early Voting for any Runoff will be open Wednesday, April 22, 2026 – Friday, April 24, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Registered electors who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Absentee applications must be requested and returned by Friday, April 3, 2026. Voters wishing for more information concerning absentee voting should contact the Cherokee County Voter Registration & Elections Office at (864) 487-2563.

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following valid Photo IDs when voting in person.

- S.C. Driver's License
  - Includes standard License and REAL ID
- S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles ID Card
  - Includes standard ID card and REAL ID
  - Includes SC Concealed Weapons Permit
- S.C Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
  - Includes all Department of Defense Photo IDs and Veterans Affairs Benefits Card
- U.S. Passport
  - Includes US Passport ID Card

If you have one of these Photo IDs, you are ready to vote. Voters should remember to bring one of these IDs with them to the polling place. Voters without Photo ID can get one free of charge from the Department of Motor Vehicles or their county voter registration office. Voters who encounter an obstacle to getting a Photo ID should bring their paper voter registration card without a photo with them to their polling place. These voters can then sign an affidavit swearing to their identity and to their obstacle to obtaining a Photo ID and vote a provisional ballot. This ballot will count unless the county board of voter registration and elections has grounds to believe the affidavit is false. At 9:00am on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, the County Board of Voter Registration and Elections will begin its examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes at Cherokee County Voter Registration and Elections located at 110 Railroad Ave, Gaffney, SC. 29340. Examination of absentee ballots for any run-off will begin at 9am on Tuesday, April 28, 2026.

At 9:00am on Friday, April 17, 2026, the County Board of Canvassers will hold a hearing to determine the validity of any provisional ballots cast in this election. On Friday, May 1, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., the Cherokee County Board of Canvassers will hold a hearing to determine the validity of all provisional ballots cast in any runoff. These hearings will be held at Cherokee County Voter Registration & Election Office located at 110 Railroad Ave, Gaffney, SC. 29340.

The following precincts and polling places will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on election day. Always check your polling place at [scVOTES.gov](http://scVOTES.gov) before leaving to vote in any election.
