Job Summary

Under general supervision of the Roads and Bridges Lead, operates a variety of heavy and light equipment to perform construction and maintenance of County roads and bridges including mowing, asphalt patching, grading, gravel placement, stormwater maintenance, and pipe construction. The position operates with considerable independence and requires sound judgment and initiative. This position requires possession of a Commercial Driver's License or the ability to obtain a Commercial Driver's License within six months of hire.

Perform Road Maintenance Projects <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Properly set up work zones that comply with Cherokee County adopted safety measures.- Ensure work areas utilize proper BMPs for erosion control measures.- Implement maintenance projects as directed by the Roads and Bridges Lead or Manager.- Utilize light, medium, and heavy equipment such as tractors, motor graders, mini excavators, and excavators to perform road maintenance projects.- Perform manual labor with hand tools as required.	75%

Equipment Maintenance 20%

- Perform pre-trip inspections on all equipment daily.
- Communicate equipment issues with the Roads and Bridges Lead.
- Operate equipment within parameters set by the County or manufacturer specifications.
- Assist with hauling equipment safely to designated locations.

Other Misc Duties as Assigned 5%

- Assist Roads and Bridges Lead or Manager with special projects.
- Maintain time, mileage, material, and other records as required.
- Attend trainings and meetings as necessary.
- Assist in after-hours emergency situations as required.

Qualifications

- Must be in possession of a Commercial Driver's License or have the ability to possess a Commercial Driver's License within 6 months of hire
- Must be able to operate a motor vehicle and in possession of a valid driver's license issued by the State of South Carolina
- Must be able to successfully pass a drug screen

Physical Demands

Must be able to frequently stoop, bend, stretch, twist, reach, kneel, squat and balance. Some work is performed indoors with exposure to fumes or airborne particles. Some work is

performed outside where employees are subject to changing weather conditions. The working conditions are typically moderately quiet compared to when operating equipment or tools. There is exposure to loud noise and vibration due to equipment. Ability to frequently lift boxes, equipment and supplies weighing up to 50+ pounds. There are some group training courses and/or meetings, mostly indoors.

Continuously requires the general ability to learn and to understand instructions and underlying principles; understand and follow oral and written instruction, and the ability to make decisions in accordance with established procedures and policies.
